**Early school closure (Friday afternoon):** Following the consultation process carried out regarding the proposal to change the finishing time of the school day on Fridays, Governors held a Special Meeting to discuss the matter and make a decision on the proposal. It was agreed to implement the change and the school day will now finish for children on Fridays at 2 o'clock with effect from the beginning of the **Summer Term on Friday**, **20**<sup>th</sup> **April 2018**. Governors were involved in the process throughout and considered the views of parents, staff and children before reaching a decision.


