




### What have EYFS been up to this week?

In Phonics this week, we have been revisiting all the sounds we have learnt so far. We are practising all of our tricky words from last half term. We have been focusing hard on writing words using our phonics knowledge. Some of us have been reading wordless books and some of us are reading books with short sentences.



In Maths, we focused on odd and even pairs. We learnt that an odd number of objects will always have a left over and an even number of objects will not and can be put in pairs. We sorted out amounts by odd and even. We learnt vocabulary such as odd, even and pair.



In Literacy, we read a story all about Chinese New Year. We learnt that the emperor chose 12 animals naming a year after each one if they won the race. We learnt the Chinese zodiac for the year we were born in and wrote about it. We also read about how people get ready for Chinese New Year and how it is celebrated.

This week, we designed our own houses for our Junk modelling workshop. On Wednesday and Thursday, parents were invited to make a house that their child had designed out of junk. All of the houses looked amazing and the children (and parents) did a great job!
