





What have The Hub children been up to this week?



In English this week, we have been focussing on recognising our own faces and names. We completed an activity of sorting photographs into 'me' and 'not me'. We also had to complete a paper based task where we had to circle how many times we could find ourselves in a poster showing ourselves and our peers.



In our communication lessons this week, we have been learning all about the core word 'some'. We have practised recognising the Widget symbol and Makaton sign for 'some' whilst sorting toys into 'some' animals or 'some' cars.



In Maths this week, we have been learning all about length. We have linked this to our transport topic by looking at long and short trains. We have been working with long trains that have 6 carriages and short trains that have just 2 carriages.



In topic this week, our focus has been Geography. Again, linking this to our topic by using the vocabulary 'here' and 'there' using trains and Makaton and widget symbols.
