Enhanced Learning Provision 'The Hub' Weekly Newsletter – 6th March 2026




What have The Hub children been up to this week?



In English this week we have been learning to develop attention and listening skills by responding to familiar environmental sounds, focussing on types of transport. We have also been enjoying looking at the marks we can make during sensory mark making activities. We have also enjoyed re-reading our familiar text - 'That's not my car'.



In our communication lessons this week, we have been learning all about the core word 'put' again. We have practised recognising the Widget symbol and Makaton sign. We enjoyed following instructions to 'put' blocks together to build towers.



In Maths this week, we have continued our work on making patterns using toy cars. We started by recognising coloured cars and sorting them before moving onto making repeated patterns.



In topic this week, we have continued learning about old and new cars. We enjoyed painting pictures of old and new cars. We know that old cars are slower and new cars are faster.



In PE this week we continued practicing following commands whilst balancing. We had to practice these skills on the floor with obstacles and then we moved onto using the benches and trestle tables.
