

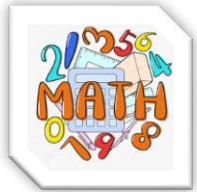
# Featherstone Primary School

This week in our Maths lessons we have been learning to subtract using the one-step and two-step method. We have subtracted by crossing out pictures, before advancing to using a number line to help us subtract numbers.
