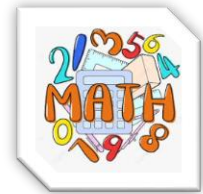
## Year 1 Weekly Newsletter – 6<sup>th</sup> March 2026

What have Year 1 been up to this week?



This week in English, we have been retelling the story Jack and the Beanstalk in our own words. We have used the story map that we made together, as well as our actions to help us remember the parts of the story. We

then began looking at voyage and return stories and how Jack and the Beanstalk fits into this structure.



In maths we looked at counting on and counting backwards. This was completed by counting the starting number, putting it in our heads and then drawing pictures to count on, or crossing off to count back. We then put these into addition and subtraction number sentences.

In topic we carried on with science where we learnt about common plants and their names. Children had to hunt for the different plants around the classroom and try guess what they were called by completing a checklist. The children then had to label the names of common plants. We then learnt about the different types of Evergreen and Deciduous trees.



Year 1 enjoyed world book day this week. They all looked lovely and enjoyed all the fun story activities that took place!



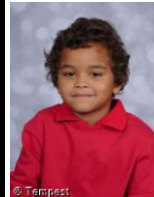
