

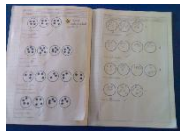
# Featherstone Primary School

What have Year 1 been up to this week?



This week in English, carrying on with Percy the Park Keeper. The children had to use their knowledge of instructions from last week to write their own instructions on how to make a jam sandwich. They had to use their ordering time conjunctions as well as the checklist for instructions including a title, imperative verbs, method and what you will need.

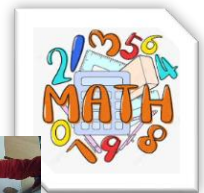


In maths we have started a new topic on multiplication. In year 1 this starts of really simply where we look at grouping and sharing. This week the children began by grouping the same amount into each groups. We focused on the key word 'equal' and what it means. They had to find out how many groups there are, then find out how many needs to go in each group and working out the total after. The children did this with objects first and then with pictures.



In topic we continued with our music and art lessons. In music we looked at composing and evaluating where the children learned about making a simple rhythm. We did this by creating a slow or fast rhythm based on the sounds we heard to come up

with a simple rhythm with my group using untuned instruments. In Art, we continued learning about the skill printing with paint. The children used leaves from the school grounds to create a repeated print pattern for Percy's wallpaper by changing the colour or shape!



In Jigsaw this week , we continued with the puzzle called 'healthy me'. In this piece of the puzzle we learned all about road safety. This included knowing how to keep safe when crossing the road, and about people who can help me to stay safe. Also recognising when I feel frightened and know who to ask for help.
