Year 1 Weekly Newsletter – 13th March 2026

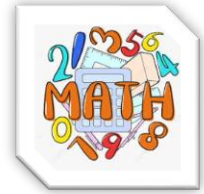
What have Year 1 been up to this week?



This week in English, we have been focusing on voyage and return stories. We have adapted the Jack and the Beanstalk story to think of some creative ideas, before planning and writing our own stories in the voyage and return structure.



In maths we have been focusing on addition and subtraction, where we began answering word problems by finding out how many are left. We then moved on to finding more and less than a given number, using bar models to support our working out.



In topic we finished our Science lessons, where we learnt about the four seasons and described what they're like, using our knowledge of different types of plants. We then started Geography, where we identified different weather patterns across the UK and made a weather report describing the weather today.



Year 1 had a science workshop for Science Week and really engaged with the science experiments!
