

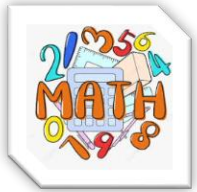
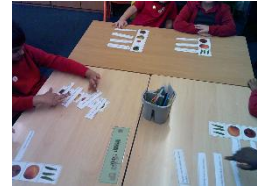
# Featherstone Primary School
