## Year 1 Weekly Newsletter – 27<sup>th</sup> February 2026

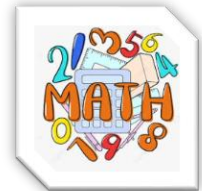
What have Year 1 been up to this week?
