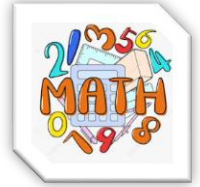


What have Year 2 been up to this week?



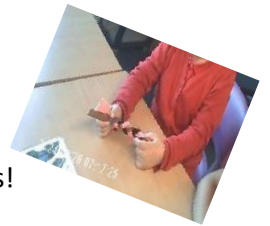
This week in English, we have been continuing our work on nursery rhymes. First, we looked at two new nursery rhymes- Jack and Jill and Little Miss Muffet. We worked in partners to find the rhyming words and then performed the poem to the class. We then created our own versions! We had to think carefully about our rhyming words, it was tricky, but we had lots of fun!

This week in Maths we have been developing our addition and subtraction skills further! We looked at adding 3, 1-digit numbers on a number line before moving onto subtraction. We know that addition can be done in any order, but subtraction can't. We subtracted on a number line and used our knowledge of tens and ones and place value charts to subtract tens from a number i.e. $67 - 20$. We have done so well with their new learning!



In Topic...

This week in Topic, we created our bags for Red Riding Hood. We recapped the purpose of the product and used our plans to create a bag to help Little Red Riding Hood carry the good to Grandmas. The new skill we were looking at was plaiting, we all created a plaited handle. It was super tricky, but we persevered and got there in the end! We are proud of our creations!



This week in P.E, we had lots of fun exploring the climbing frame again. We put all of our previous learning together and tried some partner balances where we were both holding a balance together!
