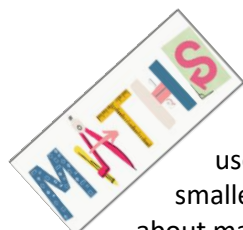
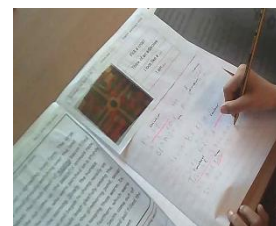


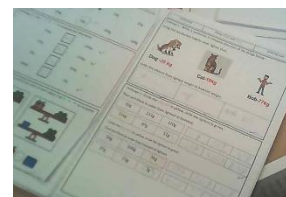


What have Year 2 been up to this week?

This week in English, we continued to explore riddles. The children enjoyed reading different riddles and then wrote their own riddles. Children used what am I? question marks, adjectives, conjunction words, clues and writing in first person to make funny and interesting riddles.



In Maths, we focused on measuring mass in grams, reading scales accurately, looking at different scales including balancing scales. We used the correct symbol $< > =$ by placing the mass in the right order from smallest to biggest and biggest to smallest. The children enjoyed learning about mass and solving word problems by understanding addition and subtraction questions.



In Topic...

This week, In Computing, we discussed what algorithms are, understood that programs work by following precise and clear instructions and exploring a new program. In Art, we explored block printing. The children learnt what printing is, looked at the different ways artist's print and they planned their own printing design thinking about different techniques we learnt about. The children experimented with patterns, shapes, and textures to create their own printed designs. They enjoyed using different materials and thinking creatively about the pressure they will use and change depending on the material used for their masterpiece.



This week in PSHE, we continued with our new topic on relationships. Keeping safe and understanding that there are lots of form of safe physical contact.
