

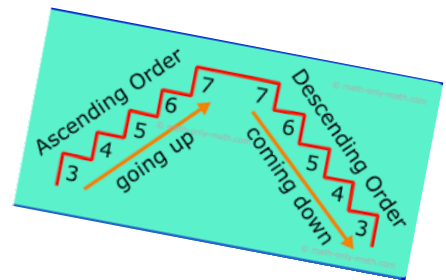
Year 2 Weekly Newsletter – 26th September

What have Year 2 been up to this week?



This week in English, we finished writing our re-telling of Little Red Riding Hood. We also explored the moral of the story and thought about the warning it gives us. Afterwards, we began writing our own advice to Little Red Riding Hood to help keep her safe from danger. Finally, the children started designing their own villains, using exciting adjectives to describe them.

This week in Maths, we have been learning about ascending and descending order. The children practised putting numbers in order from smallest to largest and from largest to smallest. They have worked hard and are becoming much more confident at spotting which numbers come before or after in a sequence.



In Topic...

In Topic this week, we have been learning Geography skills. The children explored the four points of a compass: north, south, east and west, and practiced using maps to follow directions. To put this knowledge into action, we played a fun game where we had to guide Little Red Riding Hood on her journey through the forest by following compass directions. The children worked brilliantly and had lots of fun while learning how to navigate.

In PE, we continued our gymnastics with our coach. We practiced our balances again and then worked with partners to try out new skills, such as the egg roll. The children had to concentrate carefully, use lots of strength, and make sure they were keeping each other safe while practicing.
