This week in English, we have continued reading our story “The Egyptian Cinderella”! We have looked into the vocabulary, the characters and the setting. This week we have focused on writing a setting description. We looked at adjectives and adverbs in order to make our writing exciting! After we finished writing our setting description we began to edit and improve our writing thinking about which words to use and which punctuation would be best.

This week in Maths lessons, we have been understanding place value and learning to read and represent numbers to 1000. We used part whole models to identify the place value of digits. We also used the less than and more than symbols to compare numbers to 1000.

In our arithmetic sessions, we have been practising our 2 and 3 times tables multiplication and division facts.

This week we have been learning all about Ancient Egypt in History. We have been thinking like historians, looking at sources and discovering what life was like during this period of time. We have compared life then and now, as well as looking at the advancements over time.
