




What have Year 3 been up to this week?

In our arithmetic sessions, we have been practising our multiplication and division facts for the 8 times tables. We also had TT rockstars tournament which was so much fun!

In Topic this week, we have been understanding how the muscles and skeleton work together. We understood what voluntary and involuntary muscles are and how muscles work in pairs to move a joint. We also made our very own moving hand model! We really enjoyed doing this!
