




What have Year 3 been up to this week?

We did this over two days and had a go at editing our own work, to see if we could spot any mistakes or improve our writing.



In maths this week, we have continued to look at measure! We have explored litres (l) and millilitres (ml)! We had a practical lesson where we poured water into two containers and compared the two, discussing that it was the same volume but the containers had different capacity!

In Science this week, we used magnets to see what objects in our classroom were magnetic, we conducted an experiment where we made predictions about each object discussing the material that it was made from and whether we thought this would be magnetic or not. We then tested each object and wrote a conclusion about each one!

This week we have had so much fun! We had our Eid assembly where we sang to the parents and showed how we dress to celebrate this day in school! We had our easter bonnet parade, where we displayed the hats we had made in school and at home!
