




What have Year 3 been up to this week?



In English this week, we have continued to look at diary entries. We looked at what we need to include within our diary and then how to use these purposefully. Once we had practiced all our skills, we then made a plan. We made sure we recorded each feature that we needed to include within our diary, and also what we wanted each paragraph to say. We are looking forward to writing it up next week!



This week in Maths lessons, we have been using number facts to multiply a 2 digit number by a 1 digit number. We also practised multiplying a 2 digit number by a 1 digit number using base ten and the place value table. We then moved onto multiplying using the column method.

In our arithmetic sessions this week, we have been practising adding and subtracting 100's from a 3 digit number.

In Music, we have been learning to use our voice expressively showing control over breathing, mouth shapes and posture. We ensured our rhythm and pitch were effective. We also performed as part of an ensemble using instruments and following simple musical notes on a musical staff! We then evaluated each other's performances thinking about the rhythm, pitch and texture



In PSHE this week, we have been learning about solving conflicts in families.
