




What have Year 3 been up to this week?



In English this week, we have continued to read our new story “Roman Invasion”! We have also been learning to vary our sentence openers by using prepositions of place. In addition to this, we wrote sentences using present perfect tense and this week we planned our very own non-chronological report about the Romans, ready to write up next week! This week we also celebrated World book day! The children had an amazing time looking at different authors and dressing up in characters or comfy clothes!



In maths this week, we have finished off our topic on measurement! We looked at answering word problems within addition and subtraction, and division and multiplication. Working to understand what words were used within the word problems for each, whether this was total, shared, difference between etc. We then completed our end of section review where we recapped all of our skills within measurement and completed a test!

In History this week, we have continued to learn about the Romans. We learnt about the second Roman invasion and how Claudius succeeded. We also compared Britain before and after the Roman invasion and looked at the impact the invasion had on the British Celts!
