




What have Year 3 been up to this week?



In English this week, we have been applying all our recent learning. We wrote compound sentences, used coordinating conjunctions, prepositions and speech in our writing. We have continued reading *Stig of the Dump* and we did a piece of writing in the role of one of our characters- Barney, writing in first person. In our reading lessons, we have been looking at inference type questions based on our book.



In maths this week, we have started to look at fractions. We started by looking at how to make a whole. Looking at unit-fractions, non-unit fractions, numerators and denominators. We then learnt about a tenth and how 10 tenths make a whole.

In History this week we have looked at the chronology of the Stone Age, the Iron Age and the Bronze Age. We looked at primary and secondary sources from the Bronze age, Iron age and Neolithic era. We discussed what these sources taught us about these different periods of time.



In PSHE, we have been reflecting about our ambitions and goals.
