




What have Year 3 been up to this week?



In English this week, we have looked at the features of an overcoming the monster story. We looked at which well known tales were an “over coming the monster story” and what we thought about them. We then looked at the structure of these type of tales, exploring the opening, build-up, problem, resolution and ending!



This week in Maths lessons, we have been learning to multiply 2 digit by 1 digit numbers using the expanded formal method. We then moved onto the short multiplication column method. We carefully placed our numbers in the correct place value columns and then multiplied each digit using our times table knowledge. In our arithmetic sessions, we have been practising our timestables and division facts for our 4 times tables and adding and subtracting a 3 digit and 2 digit number.

In Science, this week we have been continuing to look at our science topic of Light! This week we have explored how to stay safe in the sun, experimented with shadows and how these are made and looked at the key words opaque, transparent and translucent!



In PSHE this week, we have been looking at how a witness or bystander can help in a bullying situation.
