




### What have Year 3 been up to this week?



In English this week, we have started our new story “Roman Invasion”! We have looked at the characters and discussed what they are like and how they would feel about certain events that have happened so far!

We have also begun to look at what a non-chronological report is. We have read a few, looking at the features and what they need to include, for when we write our own.



In maths this week, we have been learning all about measurement. We looked at how to write measurement in centimeters (cm), metres (m) and kilometers (km). We then began to compare these lengths, using the words more than, less than and equal to as well as the comparison symbols  $>$ ,  $<$  and  $=$ . We have also been ordering different lengths discussing which lengths are the longest and which are the shortest.

In History this week, we had some special visitors. We were visited by some amazing historians who taught us about the Stone Age, the Iron Age and the Bronze Age. We explored many different artefacts, discussing when they would have been used and how! We also conducted an experiment where we looked at what different people ate during different time periods. Also, in history this week, we have begun to look at our Roman topic where we have been learning about the first Roman invasion!



In PSHE, we have explored the idea of making a healthy choice. We have developed our understanding of how exercise affects our body, and why our heart and lungs are such important organs!
