We made sure all our digits were in the correct place value column and then we followed the method carefully. In our arithmetic sessions, we have been practising our mix multiplication and division facts for the 2,3, 4 and 8 times tables.

In Art, this week, we have been exploring a sculpture artist- Jill Townsley. We then had a go at making a pyramid sculpture using spoons and elastic bands! We made a replica of Jill Townsley's famous sculpture 'The Pyramid'. We used lot's of techniques such as combining, arranging, folding, stretching and bending. We really enjoyed this.
