




What have Year 3 been up to this week?



In English this week we have started to look at our new story “The Iron Man”. We started off by looking at the front cover and the first page, writing predictions about what we thought the book was going to be about. After this, we began to look at a diary! We looked at the features of a diary, the sentence types we would expect to see and include and also reflected back on why these features were needed when writing a diary.



This week in Maths lessons, we have been practising using the addition and subtraction column methods to work out the missing numbers in questions! We recapped the method of exchanging and remembered how to carry over the numbers to the next column. In our arithmetic sessions, we have been looking at division facts for the times tables and understanding the pattern using the three numbers.

**In Music**, we have been learning about rhythm, pitch and texture. We then had a practice composing a piece of music changing the rhythm, pitch and texture! We also listened to some Indian music and appraised it identifying the musical features. This was so much fun!



In PSHE this week, we have been learning about different types of families.
