What have Year 4 been up to this week?

This week in writing, we have been working on grammar points for our narratives based on 'Demon Dentist'. We created expanded noun phrases to use in a detailed character description of our own villains. Then we created our descriptions using lots of show not tell sentences, similes, expanded noun phrases and ambitious vocabulary choices.



In reading, we have continued exploring 'Demon Dentist' by David Walliams, thinking about vocabulary within the different chapters, and exploring the skill of language choice. The children showed a really good understanding of why certain words had been chosen and what sort of effect it has on the story.



This week in maths, we have been exploring decimals, specifically looking at writing tenths and hundredths as decimals. The children demonstrated a strong understanding of this.

During our topic lessons, we have created presentations on how to stay safe online and the dangers that we can face when using the internet. We have also conducted an experiment into how acid effects the enamel on our teeth within our Science lesson.



In P.E this week, we have practised and refined our forehand and backhand shots, working on the accuracy of our delivery.
