What have Year 4 been up to this week?



This week in English, we have been doing a lot of grammar work, focusing on fronted adverbials and rhetorical questions, in preparation for writing a persuasive letter around the use of plastic in our world. We finished writing our biographies on Greta Thunberg, and thought about why we would write a persuasive piece next.



We also started our new text, called 'One Plastic Bag' by Miranda Paul. We have looked at vocabulary and inference within the text.

This week in Maths lessons, we have been looking at Roman Numerals to 100, putting different letters together to create larger numbers. We also learned about negative numbers and counted in steps of 25. In Maths Skills, we have been looking at our 6 times tables.
