





What have Year 4 been up to this week?

During writing, we have been focusing on rhyming poems. The children have started to write their own poems, choosing their own themes and rhyming patterns ready to perform next week!



In maths, the children have completed their NFER assessments in arithmetic and reasoning. They have also continued their learning on short division by expanding on their knowledge to enable them to divide even trickier numbers, by carrying over remainders to the ten's and one's columns.
