


What have Year 5 been up to this week?



This week in English, the children have focused on using descriptive language, compound sentences and fronted adverbials to write anecdotes about their lives. Finally, they planned their autobiographies, ready to write up and showcase. In reading, we have continued to look at different biographies and how to retrieve information from them.

In Maths, the children explored multiples, factors, common factors, and prime numbers. They began by learning how to find multiples using multiplication and identifying number patterns. Building on this, they investigated factors and common factors, using logical strategies and multiplication facts to spot numbers that share the same factors. Finally, the children learned about prime numbers, understanding that these numbers cannot be made by multiplying two whole numbers together.



In Science, we have started our topic on 'Animals, including Humans.' We have been learning about different stages in life. We created a sequenced diagram which showed the stages of the human life cycle. Moreover, in Music, we enjoyed a session with the djembe drums!
