




What have Year 5 been up to this week?



This week in English, the children focused on writing grammatically correct sentences using capital letters, a subject, a verb, an object and closing punctuation. Following this, the children planned and wrote a piece of descriptive writing about being misunderstand, which matches the themes of our class book “There’s a Boy in the Girl’s Bathroom”. Finally, we focused on the skill of noun phrases and how to use them in our grammatically correct sentence.



This week in Maths, the children explored number patterns, sequences, and rounding through a series of practical and engaging lessons. They practised counting forwards and backwards in 10s, 100s, 1,000s, 10,000s, and 100,000s to identify and complete number sequences. Using number lines, the children learned how to round numbers to the nearest 10,000 and 100,000, applying strategies such as checking the relevant place value columns to decide whether to round up or down. They also reinforced their understanding of ascending and descending order, place value, and digit values, consolidating their learning through problem-solving activities and SATs-style questions.

In Music, we have been developing our understanding of different musical elements. At the beginning of the week, we learnt about different musical notations and how to use a staff to show pitch. The children enjoyed using given notes to identify a classic nursery rhyme. On Thursday, we explored and commented on the timbre of different instruments.
