



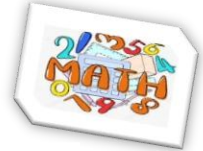
What have Year 5 been up to this week?



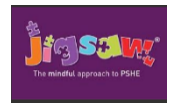

This week in maths, we have started out learning on area and perimeter. We have learnt what the term perimeter means and applied this to find the perimeter of regular shapes before using the formula $(L+W) \times 2$ to find the perimeter of rectangles.



This week in science, we have explored air resistance by completing and experiment. We made Doctor Who 3 different parachutes and explored how quickly each parachute would fall. This led us to make our conclusions using our scientific knowledge.
