




What have Year 5 been up to this week?



This week in English, the children planned and then wrote their own losing tales, applying all the Year 5 writing techniques they had been taught, including fronted adverbials, expanded noun phrases, complex sentences, speech, parenthesis, and relative clauses.

This week in Maths, we completed our unit of decimals, fractions and percentages by looking at how to convert fractions, that do not have a denominator of 100, into a percentage and completed our end of section review. We also started our geometry unit by identifying the different types of angles and began to measure them using a protractor.



This week in Science, the children prepared for the science fair by planning, carrying out, and presenting investigations. They explored different materials, considering their properties and suitability for specific purposes, such as building parts of the alchemist's machine. They also observed chemical reactions, including how bicarbonate of soda reacts with acids, and recorded their predictions, methods, results, and conclusions. Throughout the week, the children used scientific vocabulary such as solute, solvent, solution, acid, chemical reaction, and particles to explain their findings and develop their understanding of how materials can change.

In PSHE, we explored how we can be motivated to make a positive contribution to supporting others and how we can encourage our peers to support young people here and abroad to meet their aspirations.
