




Year 6 Weekly Newsletter – 27th February 2026

What have Year 6 been up to this week?

This week in writing, we have been using the picture book 'Quest' to build on our description. This meant that we designed a setting showing description, learnt how to modify noun phrases, how to use speech to create characterisation and using what we have learnt this week to create a cohesive piece of writing which included carefully chosen verbs and adverbs.



This week in maths, we have continued our focus on algebra from last half term. We learnt how to solve one-step equations, two-step equations and understanding formulae to word problems involving algebra.

In music, we began to focus on the music vocabulary used to describe a piece of music; this included tempo, pitch, dynamics, timbre, rhythm and texture. In the following lesson, we used the subject knowledge taught to analyse different songs.



In PE, we had our first gymnastics lesson where we learnt different shapes, balances and rolls.

In science, we explored the classification of all living things into groups; this included fungi, animals, plants, monera and protista. From this, we focused on how animals are classified and why they are classified in this way.



In PSHE, we were taking responsibility for our health and well-being.



We also enjoyed our weekly drumming session! We learnt how different instruments compliment each other in a piece of music.
