


# Featherstone Primary School



## Year 6 Weekly Newsletter – 6<sup>th</sup> March 2026

### What have Year 6 been up to this week?

This week in writing, we began by creating a paired write which focused on making a section of the story more interesting by using all the features that were explored and practised last week. For the remaining two lessons of the week, year 6 planned and created their short narrative.



This week in maths, we were finding pairs of values to solve equations. In our final algebra lesson, we created algebraic equations to match a worded problem. In our last lesson of the week, we moved onto the brand new unit of ratio. We began to understand what ratio is and how it can be calculated.

In music, we learnt about musical staff and musical notes by drawing the treble clef and positioning notes onto the staff.

In PE, we focused on developing balance and stability. This also meant that the children were shown how to safely create a handstand.

In science, we created a classification key to explain how each animal can be classified into each group based on its characteristics.



In PSHE, we looked at the varying types of drugs and how exploitation can occur.



On Thursday, Featherstone Primary School shared the wonderful day that is World Book Day. Year 6 took part in four different activities with four different class teachers based on different authors and books. To top off this amazing day, year 6 were able to choose two books from 1,000s donated by the charity Children's Book Project.
