




## Year 6 Weekly Newsletter – 6<sup>th</sup> February 2026

### What have Year 6 been up to this week?

This week in writing, we conducted the Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar and Reading SATs practice paper. For the remaining lessons, the children planned a build-up based on a scene from Macbeth and used the ideas from this to ask questions and make notes based on a whole class modelled write.



This week in maths, we recapped all objectives involving geometry. This included calculating angles at a point, right angles, straight line angles, and angles in triangles and quadrilaterals. For the rest of the week, we began our new topic of algebra. This meant we explored one step equations, then two step equations before forming expressions and formulae.



In design and technology, the children used the prototype they created of a Globe Theatre to create their larger scale model. The focus was on a detailed construction, focusing on the measurements and creating a high-quality finish.



In P.E this week, we were applying tactics to a game of volleyball.



In PSHE, we looked at how we could make a difference to support a global issue. The children outlined a plan to support a charity that linked to this.

We also enjoyed our weekly drumming session! We learnt how to play more rhythms and the importance of counting beats.
