



Year 6 Weekly Newsletter – 28th November 2025

What have Year 6 been up to this week?

This week in English, we planned and created a build-up to a narrative taking both the skills and techniques of the last week and inspiration from the book 'Skellig'. The focus was on building suspense by showing not telling the description, balancing action and description and using speech to develop action and convey character.

Finally, we ended the week by exploring the meaning of the Jabberwocky poem by Lewis Carroll. The children ended this lesson, with the inspiration from Lewis Carroll's style, creating their own portmanteau words.



This week in maths, our focus has been on finding percentages of amounts. This entails finding 1% (dividing the amount by 100) or finding 10% (dividing the amount by 10). From this, the children have been able to find out some tricky percentages by also using the skill of multiplication. By the end of the week, year 6 were converting percentages to both decimals and fractions to compare amounts.



During our DT lessons, the children created the pizza that they had researched and planned. Year 6 did an exceptional job creating their pizza from scratch (weighing ingredients, mixing, kneading, rolling, shaping, seasoning sauce, adding toppings and most importantly eating!).

In science, we learnt about how fossils are formed and what they can tell us about how animals have evolved over time.



In P.E, we learnt how to apply power and accuracy in our discus throws



In PSHE, we focused on why some people use bullying behaviours and managing feelings in bullying situations.
