



## Year 6 Weekly Newsletter – 19<sup>th</sup> September 2025


What have Year 6 been up to this week?



This week in English, we have continued exploring our text: Fantastic Beasts and Where to Find Them. Children have created a non-chronological report about their own creature and the qualities they possess. In this piece of writing, Year 6 have consolidated their knowledge of compound and complex sentences as well as relative clauses. On Thursday, we began our new unit on narrative by focusing

on description. Year 6 looked at the tricky task of explaining description through show not tell.

This week in maths, we have learnt about the place value of numbers to 10 million and used this knowledge to round a given number to the nearest 10, 100, 1,000, 10,000, 100,000 and 1,000,000. Furthermore, we began exploring both common factors and multiples.



In science this week, we have learnt about electricity. This meant exploring what the different symbols represent on a circuit. From this knowledge, the children created a circuit to test the impact voltage has on a buzzer and a light bulb. In art, we continued looking at Max Kostenko's style of drawing and his use of shapes to begin developing our own beast. In P.E, we have learnt how to dribble successfully in hockey.
