


## Year 6 Weekly Newsletter – 21<sup>st</sup> November 2025

### What have Year 6 been up to this week?

This week in English, we were focusing on building tension within a short narrative. In the first lesson, we explored what makes a successful build up. In the second lesson, we explored building up a picture for the reader by showing the reader rather than telling. Then, we focused on balancing both action and description before finally developing our dialogue so that it either develops action or portrays a character.



This week in maths, we learnt how calculate decimals by multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1,000. We also added and subtracted decimals, multiplied and divided decimals and found percentages of amounts, by finding 10% first.



During our science lessons, we learnt what a healthy diet looks like by discussing the food groups. We also learnt about what impact eating healthily and exercising has on the body. Additionally, we brought together all we have learnt in science over the last two weeks to design a “healthy human”. With much excitement from the children, we began our cooking topic in DT where the children investigated a range of different pizzas. We focused on its aesthetics, taste, texture and cost to make an overall judgement.



In P.E, we learnt how to apply power and accuracy in our shotput throws.

In PSHE, we explained some of the ways in which one person or a group can have power over another.
