Using number lines in addition and subtraction (Lesson 2)

This week, the children will be using a number line to solve simple addition and subtraction guestions.

This will cover the Mathematics Early Learning Goal-

Children count reliably with numbers from one to 20, place them in order and say which number is one more or one less than a given number. Using quantities and objects, they add and subtract two single-digit numbers and count on or back to find the answer. They solve problems, including doubling, halving and sharing.


Notes:

You can explore sharing practically with toys, cubes, counters etc. Children learn best through play experiences and practical demonstrations.

Keep talking to your child as the language you use will reinforce the learning.

You can print the number lines on the following page and use a small object such as a coin or button to practically work out the answer. Alternatively, you can draw your 'jumps' on each number line.
