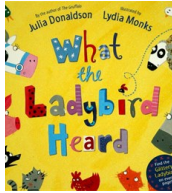


## EYFS- Topic (w/c 27/4/20)

Making a new song (Page 3)

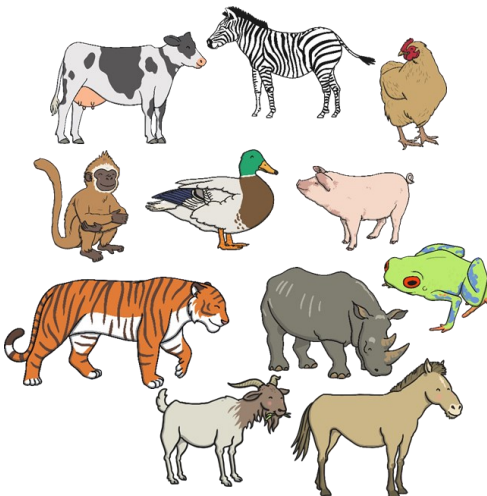
Making stick puppets (Page 4)

**Extension:** What other ways can you sort these animals out?

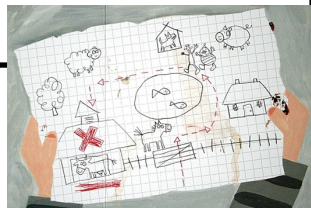
