Specific focus — Monet

W/C: 4th May 2020

Your focus this week is the artist, Monet, who was a French painter (1840—1926).

Subject: Art

Activity Outcome: To write a descriptive piece of writing on Monet's paintings, offering your opinion.

Explain: Using the pictures given, write a descriptive piece of writing, offering your opinion of the paintings. You may want to include what colours have been used and how this affects the overall view of the picture. You may want to comment on the picture itself, what has been painted? Where might you find this picture? Why do you think he has chosen to paint this particular object/place?

Here are some sentence starters to help:

This particular Monet painting interests me because he has used.....

My opinion of this picture is that..... as I can see that Monet has tried to paint.....

Subject: Art

Activity Outcome: To paint a Monet-style picture

Explain: Using the pictures provided as well as the websites and videos listed below, create your own painting. Try and use a variety of colours and a variety of brushes, thick or thin.

Subject: Spanish

Anaranjado - Orange.

Azul - Blue.

Verde - Green.

Negro - Black.
