

Year 4 – Measure – Ordering Metres and Kilometres

Remember...

- If all of the lengths are in the same unit of measure, compare them by looking at the size of the largest value first (digit furthest to the left)
- If the lengths are not in the same unit of measure, convert the metres into kilometres or the kilometres into metres so that both numbers are in the same unit of measure.
