You may find it useful to circle and draw on the story where you find the answer. If you get really stuck, the answers are at the back of this booklet.

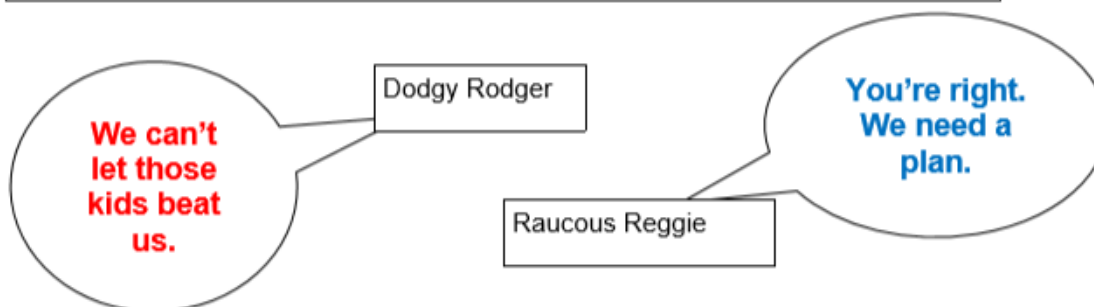
- 1) The men on the boat were Dodgy Rodger and Raucus Reggie.

- 3) At the end of the story Pete is given another mission.
- 4) Pete and Polly are brave.

- 1) It says that Dodgy Rodger and Raucus Reggie had stolen the mirror. The mirror was on the boat with 2 men. The reader assumes these are Dodgy Rodger and Raucus Reggie.
- 2) Polly and Pete left the mirror outside a grand building. Grand buildings are usually important places. Outside there was a Japanese flag.
- 3) Pete's wristwatch beeped with another message from Secret Cyril. Cyril sent them the mission to rescue the mirror. The ellipses lead us to believe that something else is about to happen, like a new mission.
- 4) Pete and Polly's actions show that they are brave. They go onto the boat to rescue the mirror even though they can hear 2 voices arguing.
