Re: Covid-19 Resilience Funding

During these uncertain times, many families may be struggling to meet bills or other such payments due to varying circumstances. Birmingham City Council have allocated funding to directly support individual families through the Covid-19 emergency period and longer-term impact. This is called Covid-19 Resilience Funding.

Resilience Funding will be available from Birmingham City Council for families in **extreme hardship** and may need some sort of urgent financial support for daily emergency necessities.

- May be struggling to buy enough food;
- May not have the funds for medication or to access baby supplies;
- May be finding it difficult to pay for utilities such as gas, electric or water bills;
- May not have enough finances for an emergency i.e. a broken freezer or washing machine.

Please be aware this is for families who have **genuine reason** for applying and applications will be approved on a case by case basis. The maximum amount allocated per application is £150.

The process will require for Mr Gravell to complete a short application with you and once submitted, if successful and approved, you may be allocated some funding.

The cutoff date for the first round for you to apply is 8th May 2020. There will also be further opportunities.
