Coronavirus

You are aware of the outbreak of novel Coronavirus and the subsequent confirmed cases in the UK. There's currently no cause for concern at the school, but we'll keep you informed about any developments and ensure that we're keeping the school clean to prevent the spread of any virus. However a number of parents have emailed to ask questions and I have compiled some answer below.

Are children being taught about Coronavirus in school?

All children from EYFS to Year 6 have had lessons and also assemblies on the effects and spread of the virus. This was pitched at an appropriate age level and cartoon clips were also used for the younger children so that they have a better understanding.

Are children following the general principles to prevent spreading (Hand Hygiene and Respiratory Hygiene)?

Teachers are ensuring that children wash their hands and reminding them how to do this. Children are also reminded about covering when coughing or sneeze with a tissue, then throwing the tissue in a bin.

Are visitors and staff entering the building signposted to wash hands and use sanitiser?

All visitors and staff entering and leaving the building are asked to either wash their hands or use the recommended sanitiser provided by the school.

Are site staff maintaining high standards of hygiene?

Our staff are continuously wiping all areas of the school which include doors, door handles, banister stair rails etc. Our cleaning staff make an early start from 3pm so that maximum cleaning hours are used.

How is cutlery and crockery handled in the hall?

In the hall children are not allowed to handle the cutlery, this is now passed to them one at a time by a member of staff.

If the school is to close, will home work be sent home?

Our managers are currently in the process of creating a range of material which can be used by you and your children so that they can continue with their learning at home. This will include:

- Online material (tests etc)
- Paper based workbooks prepared by class teachers for children to work at home
- Online reading and learning material
- Maths tests practice (TT Rockstar's)
- English reading—Bug club
- Also you have the Home Learning Passports which can also be completed
