Dear Parents and Carers,

Hall Expansion Build – Parent Access on to school site from Monday 21st March 2022

Following from my last communication, we have now finalised the programme works. The hall expansion work will start on **Monday 21st March 2022** and last approximately 24 weeks, ending in August 2022.

The company we have chosen to carry out the work is Zone Cee Ltd. They will be working very closely with us in managing this project. The area that they will be working in will be fenced off, and not accessible for anyone other than Zone Cee staff, or other contractors.

Through the time of the project, there will be minimum disruption in the day to day routines at school. The existing school hall will still continue to be used for lunch, assemblies and any P.E lessons. The school field can still be used by the children and there will be no disruption to any of their sports lessons.

The only change that will take place is the drop off and collection points for parents at the start and end of the school day, which will be as follows from Monday 21st March:

MORNING DROP OFF POINTS

EYFS: Use the same entrance as normal

Year 1, 2, 3 and 4: Use the entrance located by the school office

Year 5 and 6: Use the entrance by the bike shelter

High Achievers – Before school childcare: Parents dropping off for High Achievers in the morning, the EYFS gate will be open from 7.30am. Please walk through this area, around the classrooms to the back of the school to the portakabin. Please remember to walk your child/ren round and not send them alone.


SCHOOL FINISH COLLECTION POINTS:

EYFS: Use the same entrance as normal

Year 1, 2, 3,4 and 5: Parents will need to use the entrance located by the school office, walk through the atrium, and into the playground. Each class will have a designated area, which will be labelled so that you know where to collect your child/ren from. The doors will be supervised by our site staff and will be open at 3.25pm Monday to Thursdays and 12.50pm on Fridays. Once parents have collected their child/ren, they can leave from the same atrium entrance.

Year 6: Year 6 children will come out from the entrance by the bike shelter.

High Achievers – Afterschool Childcare: Parents collecting from High Achievers at the end of the day, the EYFS gate will be open. Please walk through this area and walk round to the portkabin.


The Book Swap Shop has been running for two weeks now – it has been great to have Years Three and Four come along and swap an unwanted book for another! Year Five: it's your turn next week!
