Everyone made a real effort to dress up in either 'sports' or in yellow!












Attendance and Punctuality

School have recently begun working with 'CSAWS,' (Central School Attendance and Welfare Service). CSAWS work on site for a few hours each week and help promote good attendance and punctuality for all our families. They will also work with, and monitor, parents who do not send their child/ren to school on time. If this is the case, a punctuality action plan will be in place.

It saddens me to say that, despite having clear policies for attendance, some parents do not work with school and, as a result, their children have very poor attendance/persistent absences. School passes these attendance details to the Birmingham Legal Team (ELIT), who may issue a Penalty Notice (fine). Recently fines are:

- 5 parents received a £60 penalty notice
- 2 parents received a £120 penalty notice
- 2 parents received a £609 penalty notice
- 1 parent received a £644 penalty notice

However, nearly 250 children visited the Attendance Shop last half term for excellent attendance! Well done to you!

Late Fines

In line with our Late Collection of Pupils Policy, please remember school finishes at 3:25pm and children must be collected by this time. Any parent collecting after 3.35pm with 3 lates in a term, will be issued a £15 fine.
